### **Tag Rugby**



Tag rugby is a non-contact form of rugby widely played as a social sport. Ours is a mixed league. A team consists of up to 15 players (at least four of each gender). Seven players are on the field at any time (at least three of each gender). Unlimited substitutions and interchanges are permitted during the game which lasts for two 20 minute halves.

### Why get involved?

Tag rugby is a great way for colleagues to get together after work to socialise in a healthy outdoor environment. Additional activities that run alongside the league include BBQs and other social events on game nights, informal Tue training and pints, and a Grand Mystery Tour. Our tag league is the ideal way for colleagues new to the area to develop new friendships, networks and social groups. We provide full instruction for inexperienced players, so there is no excuse for anyone not to get involved !

### How your organisation benefits

We maintain a very active presence on social



media, and news from our league is widely shared. We receive good coverage in the local print media. ### No experience necessary

We welcome and encourage players with little or no prior experience of any team sport. We run free training weeks prior to the start of the league so that new and inexperienced players and teams can be coached in the basics of the game. We run grading games to ensure that teams of equal ability are matched against one another in the league. Our coaches and referees are all IRFU/Connacht Rugby qualified and take a pragmatic and sensible view of games, emphasising flow, fairness and fun.

You don't need any special equipment to start - just comfortable clothing and suitable footwear. To play in the league you will need approved tag shorts which we sell at the venue
